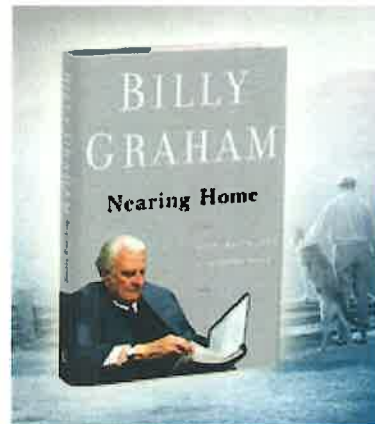
The chapters are grounded in Scripture, where he shares examples from the lives of the Bible's aged saints, as well as verses of encouragement and bits of wisdom.

"I had been taught all of my life how to die, but no one had ever taught me how to grow old," said Graham. The book encourages its readers to see growing old, not as something to dread, but as something to embrace as part of God's plan for their lives.

"When granted many years of life, growing old in age is natural, but growing old with grace is a choice," say Graham. "Growing older with grace is possible for all who will set their hearts and minds on the Giver of grace, the Lord Jesus Christ."
